

#### Visual Editor for HTML Emails

#### Enhanced email template editor lets you create formatted messages with links and images

isolved email templates now support HTML, so you can use the intuitive new email editor to design messages that include formatted text, bullets, numbered lists, paragraph indentation, hyperlinks, and images. The HTML editor is available for mass emails and email templates, so you can update benefit and workflow emails to make them more engaging. You can still insert variables into your email templates from the Variables menu that will automatically be filled in when the emails are generated.



#### Editing mobile notifications is easier



The **Client Email Templates** screen has also been updated to make finding your email templates easier. You can now search and filter by email type, subject, or template status.




# **EEO-1 Component 1 Data Files for Upload**

#### EEO-1 Export provides Component 1 data in the required EEOC format


Private employers with 100 or more employees and federal government contractors with 50 or more employees are required to submit demographic workforce data to the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC) annually. This demographic workforce data, referred to as Component 1, includes metrics for race/ethnicity and gender by job category. The EEOC has opened their online portal so employers can submit Component 1 data for 2019 and 2020 by Monday, July 19, 2021. For companies who have been tracking ethnic origin, gender, EEO classifications in isolved, the new **EEO1 Export** is formatted as a comma-delimited (csv) file for upload to the <u>EEO-1 Component 1 Online Filing System</u>. This report is available on the Reports > Client Reports menu in the **HR Compliance Reports** category.





## Establishments screen links work locations to EEO-1 reporting establishments

To use the isolved **EEO1 Report** or **EEO1 Export**, you need to link your work locations to EEO establishments and assign your company headquarters on the **Establishments** screen for accurate reporting.

## **Local Tax Changes for Pennsylvania Non-Residents**

PA local income tax withholding is now required for employees who live in Maryland but work in certain Pennsylvania jurisdictions

Pennsylvania state law requires non-resident tax to be withheld for Pennsylvania employees residing in other states. Pennsylvania local tax collection bureaus can form agreements superseding state law to allow an exemption from non-resident municipal taxes for Maryland residents. Results from a recent audit of Pennsylvania tax collection bureaus requires withholding of non-resident tax in the jurisdictions that were previously exempt.

Although these changes will occur automatically for payrolls posted after the isolved version 7.11 release on June 25, 2021, the audit requires retroactive withholding back to January 1, 2021. Insperity is working with isolved to gather a list of all impacted employees who will need additional retroactive Pennsylvania local income tax withholding.

For employers with Pennsylvania work locations, your Payroll Specialist will contact you if you have employees who reside in Maryland and worked in one of the impacted Pennsylvania locations.
